

Speak at a City Council Meeting

If you would like a particular item placed on the agenda or would like to address the Mayor and Council, you may do so by contacting the Office of the City Clerk and submitting your request in writing at least 5 business days before the meeting. In addition, each council meeting has a 10 minute public input period where citizens can address Mayor and Council on any topic. If you would like to utilize the public input period, you would need to attend a council meeting on the 1st or 3rd Thursday of each month and sign up with the City Clerk to speak.
