



Household Waste Guidelines



Must be at curb before 6:00AM on collection day



Maximum of 8 additional bags or bundles of household trash, Yard waste, or a combination of the 2 without exceeding 8



All trash must be bagged. All back door customers must use garbage bags Kitchen size or larger. No small bags please.



NOT ACCEPTABLE: tires, batteries, paints, oils, construction material, chemicals of any kind, freon, rocks, sand, gravel, dirt, logs, carpet, hazardous or medical waste



All boxes (maximum of 20 or 30 depending on size) must be broken down and placed at the curb



BULK ITEMS (i.e. sofas, chairs, mattresses, washer, dryers) will be accepted on your day of service, however, refrigerators, air conditioning units, freezers are not acceptable at this time because they contain freon. Gas grills are acceptable but only if propane tank is removed. Remember, construction material is not accepted. Please call 404-794-6707 and press 3 to order a small container for home improvement jobs. Lawn mowers are accepted only if gasoline is removed. All Bulky items must be placed at curb the night before regular pick up day no earlier than 6:00 p.m.

Yard Waste Guidelines



Limbs must be bundled and tied with rope or string. Bundles may not exceed 30 lbs & cannot be greater than 4 ft long and 4 inches in diameter.



Weekly limit of (8) eight brown recycle bags, bundles or combination of the two (not to exceed the 8 bag limit for trash, and yard waste)



Must be at curb before 6:00AM on collection day.



Grass clippings and leaves must be in paper yard debris bags or placed loose in a separate container labeled "Yard Waste"



NOT ACCEPTABLE: tree trunks, limbs greater than 4 inches in diameter, whole trees, logs, dirt, rocks, Christmas trees

Recycling Guidelines



We collect loose newspaper, magazines, mixed paper, bond stock, letterhead, manila cards, writing paper, chipboard, phone books, clean plastics #1 - #7, steel and tin cans and aluminum cans, all three colors of glass (Brown, Clear and Green) and flattened cardboard. All items must fit inside recycling bin including cardboard. There is a cardboard recycling dumpster at City Hall for larger boxes.



Must be at curb before 6:00AM on collection day in a WM bin



In case of rain, please hold newspapers until the following week



NOT ACCEPTABLE: Aluminum foil, used files, wrapping paper, invoices, register rolls, printouts, envelopes, photocopy paper and wrappers, plastic bags, aerosol cans, bottle caps, light bulbs, dishware, pots & pans, Styrofoam/packaging, or hangers
