An employee in this job is considered to be an Essential Emergency Worker and are subject to be on call. The position is designated as Safety-Sensitive and will be subject to unannounced random drug screen testing.

Minimum Requirements

Ability to read, write and perform mathematical calculations at a level commonly associated with the completion of high school or equivalent.

Sufficient experience to understand the basic principles relevant to the major duties of the position, usually associated with the completion of an apprenticeship/internship or having had a similar position for one to two years.

Possession of or ability to readily obtain a valid driver's license issued by the State of Georgia for the type of vehicle or equipment operated. An incumbent in this position may be designated "Public Works Technician II" with the possession of a Class A Commercial Driver's License.
